A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A LIMB PICKUP/YARD WASTE POLICY FOR THE CITY OF WARD RESIDENTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, THE CITY OF WARD wishes to adopt and implement a policy for quarterly limb pickup and yard waste removal for its residents; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WARD THAT:

SECTION 1: THE CITY OF WARD hereby adopts the attached "Limb/Yard Waste Policy."

SECTION 2: This policy DOES NOT apply to commercial property or property being cleared for a subdivision or the like.

SECTION 3: THE MAYOR AND/OR HIS/HER DESIGNATED AGENT(S) are hereby authorized to direct implantation of this policy and make minor changes as deemed necessary without further council approval.

## CITY OF WARD LIMB/YARD WASTE POLICY

1. **Schedule:** Limbs and yard waste, per this policy and properly staged, will be collected by the city on the second Tuesday of the following months:
  - a. February
  - b. May
  - c. July
  - d. October
  
2. **Items the City WILL accept**
  - a. Tree limbs and brush limbs NO longer than 6 feet in length and NO larger than four (4) inches in diameter
  - b. Yard waste (leave, grass clippings, hedge trimmings) must be in biodegradable bags and stacked for easier loading
  
3. **Placement of Material**
  - a. ALL material must be placed near but not in any drainage ditch in FRONT of your home no sooner than 3 days prior to pick up.
    - i. Please **DO NOT** place material in the drainage ditch and this may impede the flow of stormwater and cause unnecessary flooding.
    - ii. Please **DO NOT** place on or near a water meter, gas meter, sewer manhole or on the roadway.
  - b. Material that is too large or not properly bagged will NOT be picked up
  
4. **Items the City WILL NOT accept**
  - a. Bags containing dirt or garbage
  - b. Tree stumps
  - c. Un-bagged leaves, grass clippings, or hedge trimmings
