**A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS OF CITY OF WARD
TO UTILIZE FEDERAL-AID TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM OR
RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM FUNDS**

WHEREAS, THE CITY OF WARD understands Federal-aid Transportation Alternatives Program or Recreational Trails Program Funds are available at 80% federal participation and 20% local match to develop or improve the **Moore Street Sidewalk and Railroad Crossing**, and

WHEREAS, THE CITY OF WARD understands that Federal-aid Funds are available for this project on a reimbursable basis, requiring work to be accomplished and proof of payment prior to actual monetary reimbursement, and

WHEREAS, this project, using federal funding, will be open and available for use by the general public and maintained by the applicant for the life of the project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WARD CITY COUNCIL THAT:

SECTION I: The City of Ward will participate in accordance with its designated responsibility, including maintenance of this project.

SECTION II: Mayor Charles Gastineau is hereby authorized and directed to execute all appropriate agreements and contracts necessary to expedite the construction of the above stated project.

SECTION III: The Ward City Council pledges its full support and hereby authorizes the Arkansas Department of Transportation to initiate action to implement this project.
